

Participation Conduct Policy

AIMCHURCH.ONLINE – Zoom Live Ministry Gatherings

The 10 AIMCHURCH Zoom Culture Principles

1. We Honor God First

Welcome everyone to AIMCHURCH.ONLINE. Our first focus today is to honor Jesus Christ and receive from His Word together.

2. We Keep Our Microphones Muted

Please keep your microphone muted unless the host invites you to speak. This helps everyone hear clearly without distractions.

3. We Minimize Background Noise

Please make sure televisions, conversations, and other background noises are turned off so we can maintain a peaceful environment.

4. We Speak One at a Time

If you would like to share, please raise your hand or notify the host in the chat and wait to be invited to speak.

5. We Use the Chat to Encourage

The chat is for encouragement—feel free to say “Amen,” share a Scripture, or support others in a positive way.

6. We Avoid Criticism or Debate

To maintain unity, we avoid negative criticism, arguments, or doctrinal debates during the service.

7. We Respect and Value Every Person

Every person here matters. We speak with kindness, patience, and honor toward one another.

8. We Listen with Open Hearts

When someone is speaking, we listen attentively and allow them the space to share without interruption.

9. We Serve and Encourage One Another

Our goal is to build one another up in faith, prayer, and spiritual growth.

10. We Expect God to Move

Come with faith and expectation that God will speak, encourage, and bring a breakthrough today.

“Thank you for helping us create a respectful and Spirit-led environment here at AIMCHURCH.ONLINE. Let’s open our hearts and receive what God has for us today.”

Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to create a respectful, peaceful, and spiritually focused environment where every participant can grow in faith, worship freely, and receive from God without distraction or disorder.

AIMCHURCH.ONLINE Zoom gatherings are designed to encourage spiritual growth, fellowship, discipleship, and breakthrough through the Word of God.

1. Spirit of Participation

All participants are encouraged to join meetings with a heart of humility, love, and respect for others.

Each person should aim to:

- Encourage others in faith
- Listen attentively to the message or teaching
- Participate in a spirit of unity and peace
- Support the purpose of the gathering

The focus is not on personal attention, but on **honoring God and serving one another.**

2. Muting and Speaking Order

To maintain a clear and orderly meeting environment:

- All participants should **remain muted when entering the meeting.**
- Participants should **only unmute when invited by the host or leader.**
- If you wish to speak, you may:

- Raise your hand using the Zoom feature
- Notify the host through the chat
- Wait for the moderator to invite you to speak

This allows everyone to hear clearly and keeps the meeting peaceful and organized.

3. Avoiding Background Noise and Distractions

To maintain a respectful worship and teaching environment:

Participants should avoid:

- Background conversations
- Television or music noise
- Loud environments
- Interrupting the speaker
- Moving around with an unmuted microphone

If you are in a noisy environment, please keep your microphone muted at all times.

This helps ensure that everyone can focus on the Word of God and the moment of ministry.

4. Respectful Use of Chat and Comments

The chat feature should be used to **encourage, support, and affirm the message**, not to create confusion or criticism.

Acceptable chat comments include:

- Encouraging Scripture
- Affirmations such as “Amen” or “Praise God”
- Positive encouragement to others

Participants should avoid:

- Negative criticism
- Correcting others publicly
- Debating doctrine in the chat
- Posting unrelated links or messages

The goal of the chat is **unity and encouragement, not debate or distraction.**

5. Honoring and Respecting One Another

Every participant on AIMCHURCH.ONLINE Zoom gatherings should feel valued and respected.

Members are encouraged to:

- Speak kindly to one another
- Show patience and understanding
- Celebrate the spiritual growth of others
- Avoid judgment or criticism

The ministry environment should reflect **the love and character of Jesus Christ.**

6. Focus of the AIMCHURCH.ONLINE Community

The focus of our Zoom gatherings is to:

- Grow in the Word of God
- Encourage one another spiritually
- Pray and support one another
- Discover and walk in God-given purpose
- Build a community centered on Christ

Each participant plays a role in creating a **healthy spiritual environment.**

7. Serving One Another in Groups

Participants are encouraged to serve the community by:

- Praying for others
- Encouraging those who are struggling
- Welcoming new participants
- Listening respectfully when others share

True participation means building others up, not drawing attention to oneself.

8. Maintaining a Peaceful Online Environment

- To protect the spiritual atmosphere of the gathering:
- The host or leadership team may mute microphones, guide the conversation, or redirect the meeting when necessary to maintain order.
- This helps ensure that every meeting remains focused, respectful, and spiritually fruitful.
